Here is the new update the comprehensive collection of people who fought in the Civil War, both Confederate and Union, who died in Jackson County. There is also a limited number of Jackson County natives who entered the war from Alabama and moved on after the war. There is a surprising number of Union soldiers who spent time in Alabama and returned here after the war, whether it was the country or some young lady that drew them back to Jackson County. There are many stories to tell here. There is one African-American who served in the US Colored 101st Infantry. There are lots and lots of siblings. A few fathers and sons. At least one instance where members of the same family fought on different sides. There is a set of Precise twins who served together.

This text file and the virtual cemetery that goes with it enable you to search Civil War veterans across Jackson County. This is the first version of this file that is based on the ALGENWEB file of Civil War Veterans from Jackson County compiled by Linda Ayer, in May 2003. Her listing was based on pension records. This listing is based on findagrave records.

Our county is fortunate to have a long line of diligent volunteers who have collected cemetery information and most of that has found its way into findagrave. The Matthews sisters, Leola in particular, began collecting this information in looseleaf notebooks in the 1930s. Mrs. Proctor whose work is collected into volumes in the library did some much good work on cemeteries and family Bible records in the 1960s. Others have traipsed through fields and braved the snakes to capture tombstone information. Barry Pickett and Ralph Mackey did a lot of this even before Jane Nichols and her husband visited nearly every cemetery in the county in the 1990s.

We have had a whole bevy of wonderful findagrave volunteers—Ann Tomerlin, Beth Presley, Carol Ballard, MIchelle Urban, Bobby and his sweet wife, who has passed. Others I run across regularly but cannot recall in my sinus-induced fog this morning.

And all this has culminated today in an online searchable database owned by Ancestry, who also owns Fold3 for military data and newspapers.com for the country's newspaper history. By linking these databases with all the vast holdings of Ancestry and all the collected history of findagrave volunteers, we now have incredible family research capabilities. I belonged to Ancestry when it first started up and it took a lot of street smarts to trace families. Now Ancestry does it for you. It is an incredible facility that adds new collections all the time. For a recent article, I talked to the Library of Congress and their researcher said, look we have this online but it is easier to find through Ancestry.

The list of Civl War soldiers is a flat text file, not a database. Findgrave is a database. Having the text file lets you search across all the finadagrave records for commonalities. For example, you could search the text file on "Vidette" to find all those men who served in the 1st Alabama and Tennessee Vidette Cavalry or "nitre" to find the men who mined salt peter. The broader you search, the better because there is no consistency in how the headstones refer to the

regiments and companies. I did my best to address this, but I am not a Civil War expert, and if I take time to become one, I will neglect everything else I work on.

When I could, I improved the record I found. I added ancestry records that proved what regiment these men had been members of. I contacted photo owners and added photos to some records and information about Civil War Service to others. I attached some of the pictures I found of interest and did a bit of cleanup on.
