

THE HARRIS FAMILY

- Transcribed -

The following family history was taken from the Journal of Francis Eppes Harris, son of Richard Harris, born November 20, 1758, died January 20, 1853, Madison County, Alabama, and is buried on his old plantation near Huntsville. Richard Harris was a Revolutionary soldier. This book has been handed down from Francis Eppes Harris to his daughter Beatrice Eugenia Harris Keeble to her daughter Carrie Keeble Thompson to her daughter Fay Beatrice Thompson Sumner to her son William Parks Sumner, Jr. It has been copied verbatim in another part of this volume but here it has been broken down into families by Christine Paradise Sumner...
