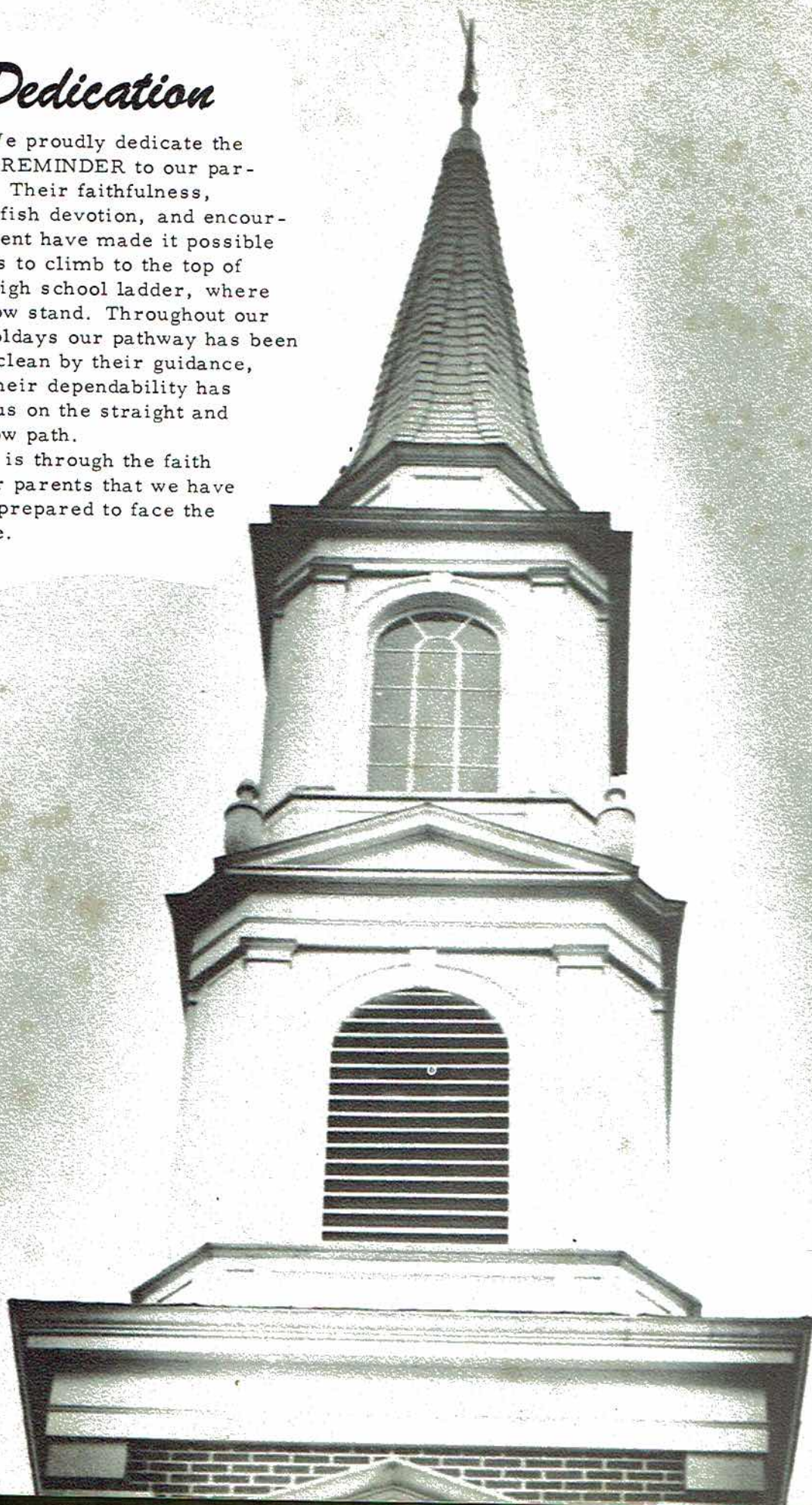
Foreword

And before you marry, read carefully these scriptures: Matt. 5:31-32; Matt. 19:3-9 Eph. 5:23-33.
