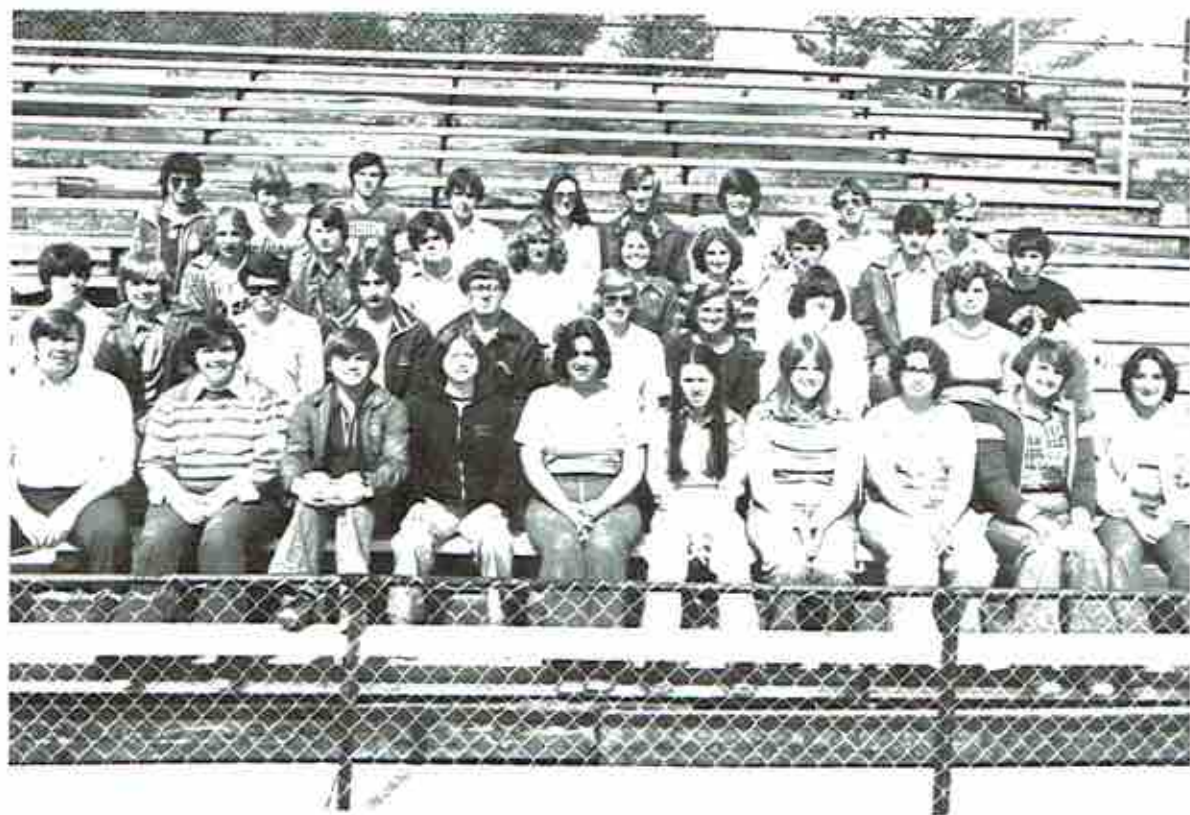
R.O.T.C.
