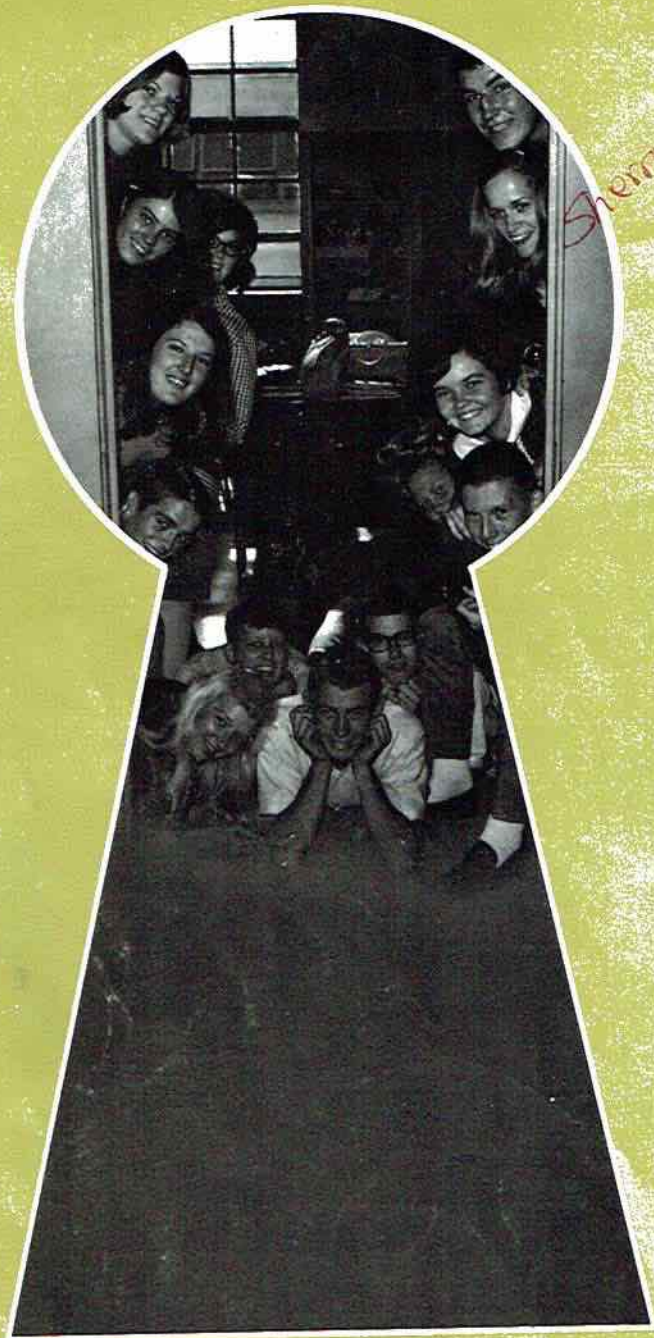

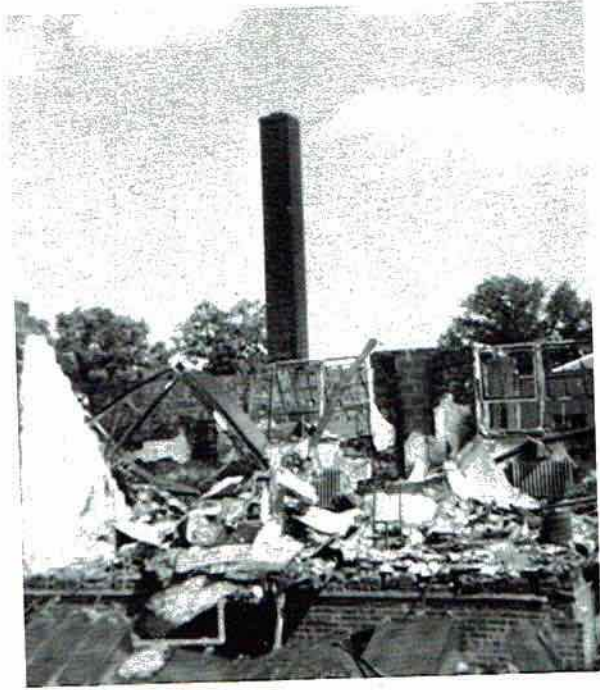
Disaster Strikes

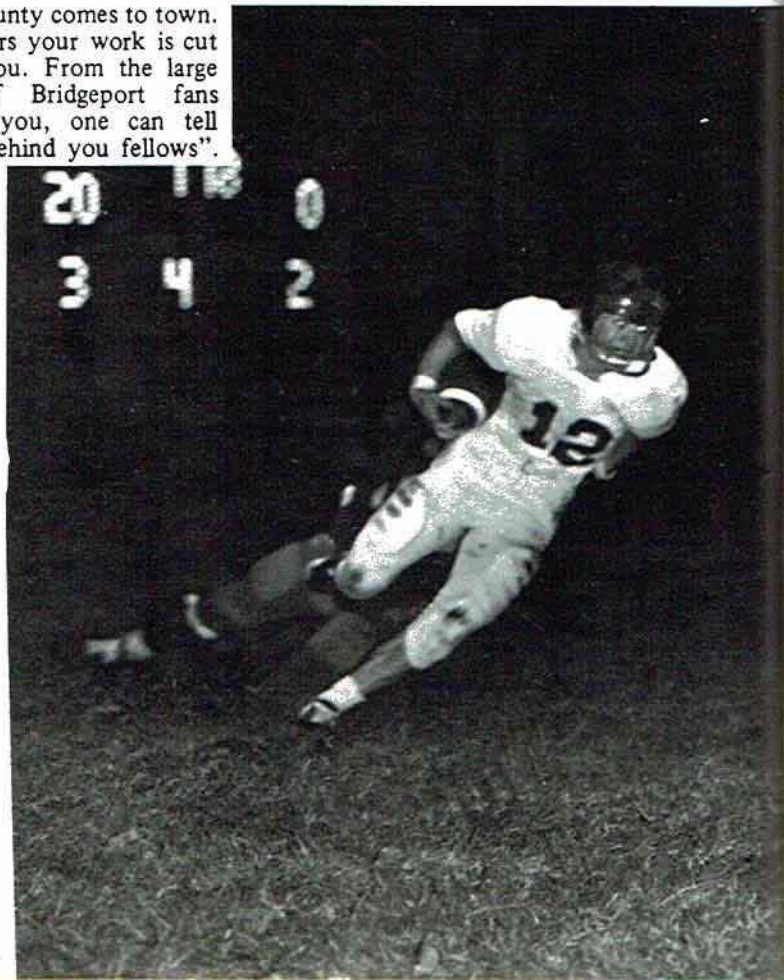


Tigers - Pisgah Eagles Fight to a Draw 0-0
