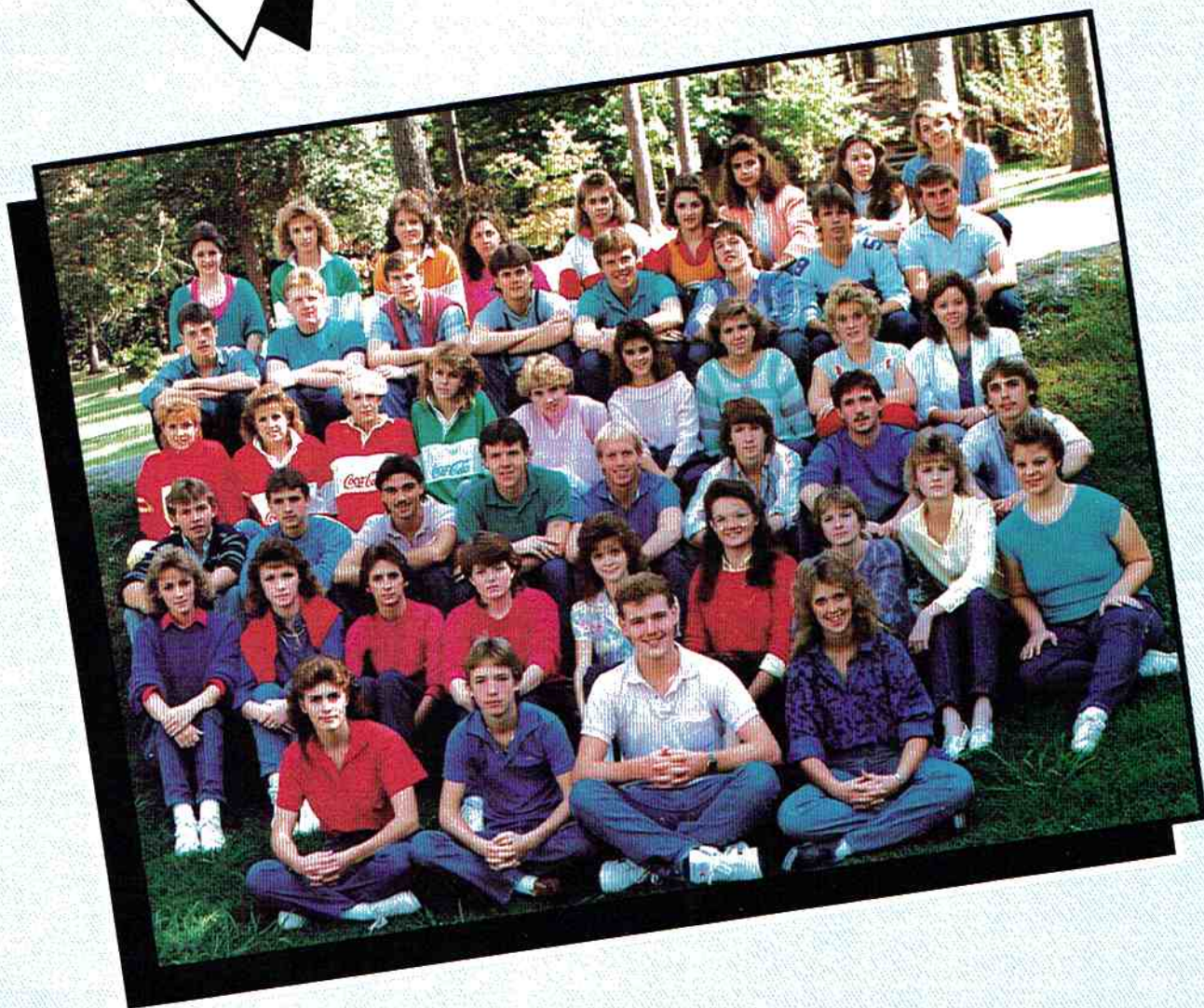

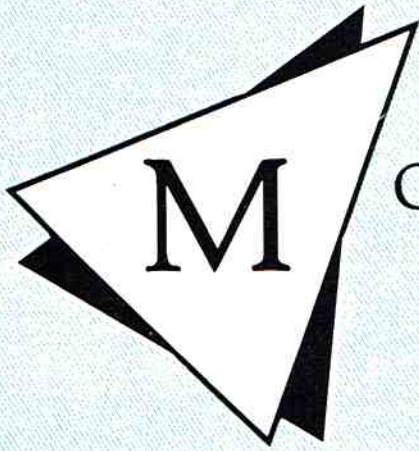

For her outstanding achievements and dedication, both in and outside the classroom, the 1987 Cameo is dedicated to Mrs. Joan Reeves.







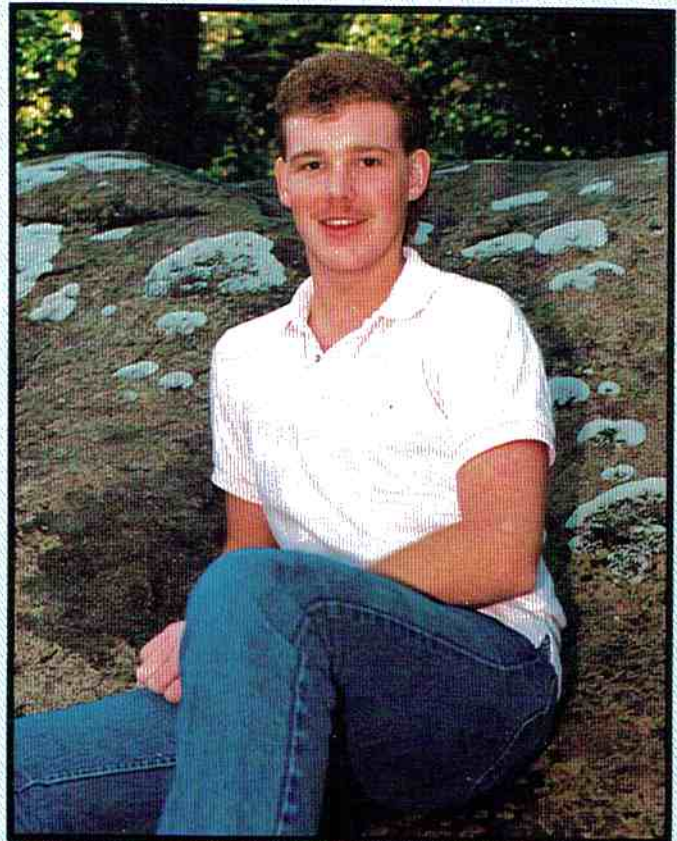

Danette plans to attend Northeast Junior College and pursue a career in business management or banking and finance.

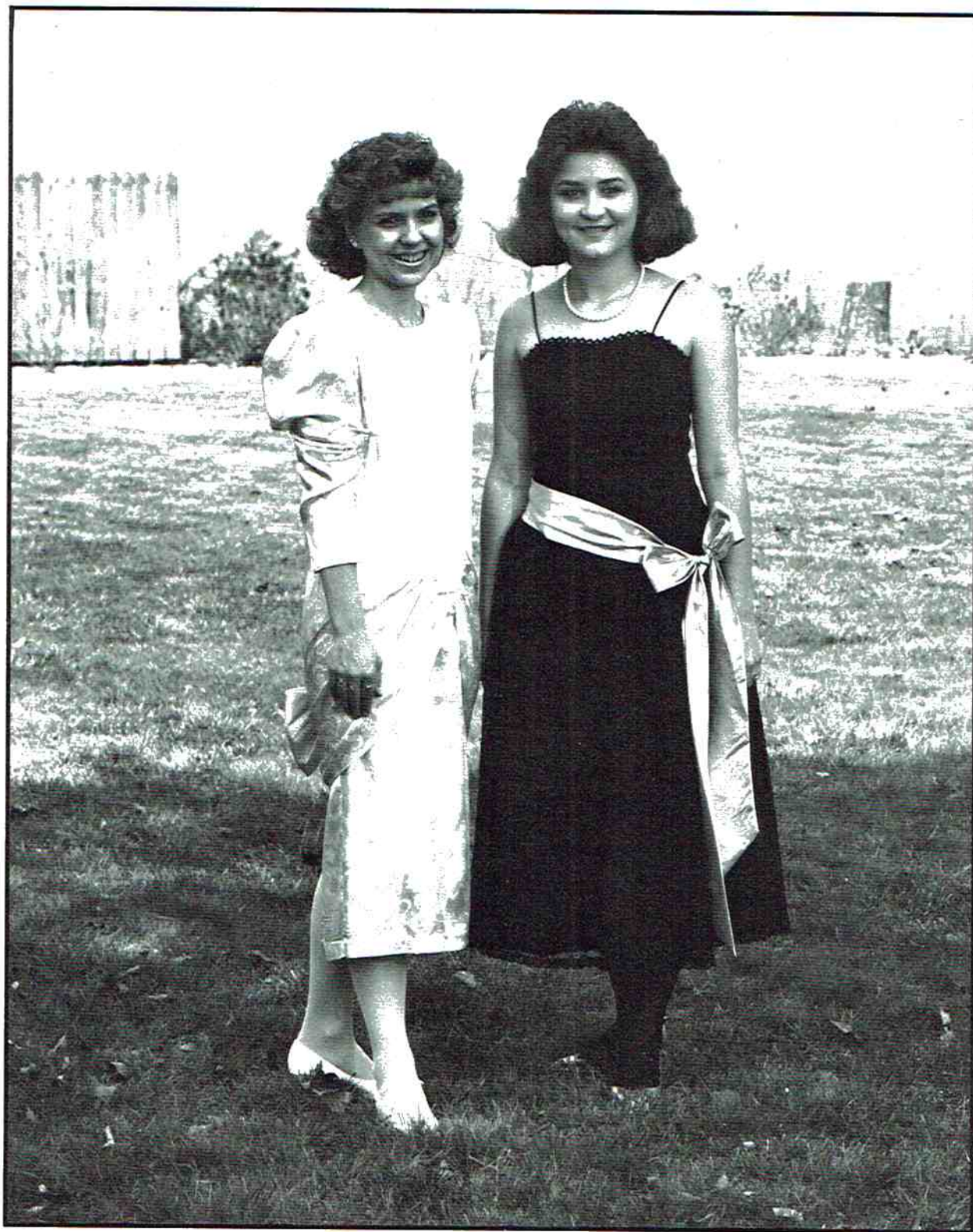

Mr. Calvin B. Strickland

For forty years Coach Calvin B. Strickland has been an educator at Skyline, Geraldine, Section, and North Sand Mountain schools. He coached basketball for thirty-three of those years and enjoyed a phenomenal record of 689 wins. He was involved in winning six Sand Mountain Tournament championships, six county championships and eight area championships.

Coach Strickland took five teams to state tournaments and in 1969 won the 2A state championship with a Section team. He was named Alabama 2A Coach of the Year that year and during his career was county Coach of the Year three times and Tri-State Coach of the Year once. If only one word could be used to sum up his career it would have to be "winner".

During his fourteen years at NSM his friendly personality and excellent character earned him the respect and admiration of students and fellow faculty members. His work at North Sand Mountain is greatly appreciated and we wish him many years of health and happiness.

She began her teaching career in 1947 at North Sand Mountain's forerunner, Mount Olive Junior High. She transferred to North Sand Mountain in 1968 and has spent the past nineteen years helping various levels of students develop the gift of reading in remedial reading classes.

During her career, Mrs. Buckner endeavored to set the right example for her students and practice her personal philosophy of putting God first. In 1984 she was nominated for the Jacksonville State University Teacher Hall of Fame and honored by her colleagues as Jackson County Elementary Teacher of the Year.

How beautiful a career can be when kindness and compassion touch it. We wish Mrs. Buckner a long happy retirement.

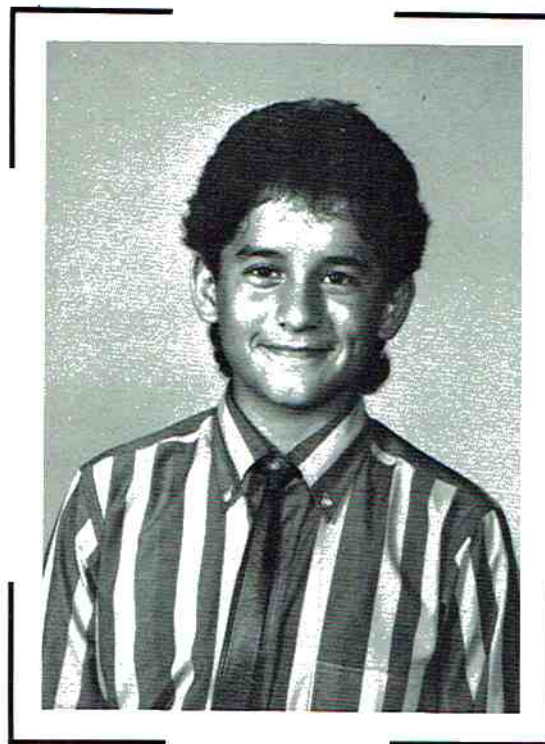
