## *Senior Class History*

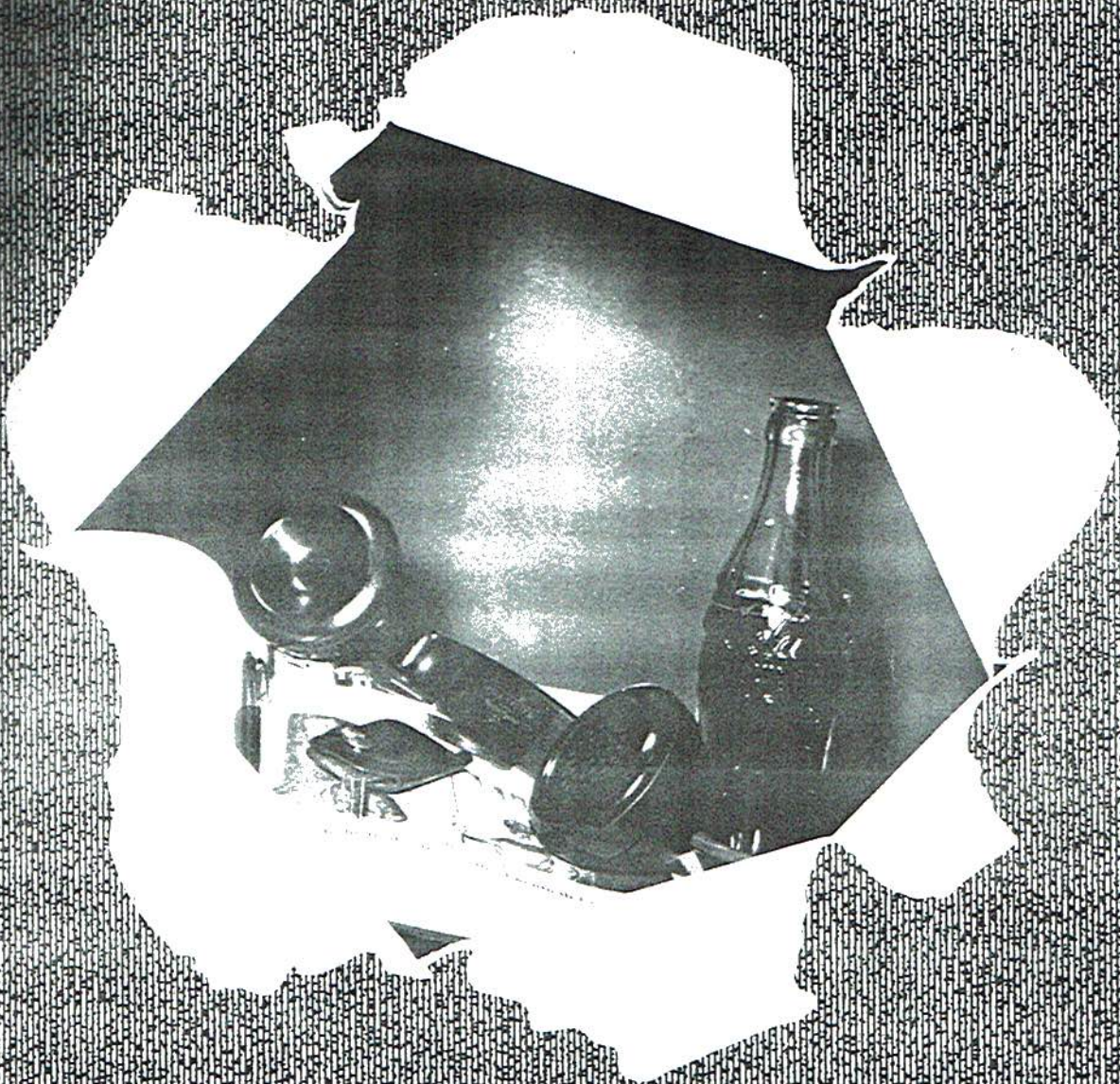

Our class colors are Blue and Silver, our motto: Push, Pull or get out of the way. The carnation is our favorite flower.

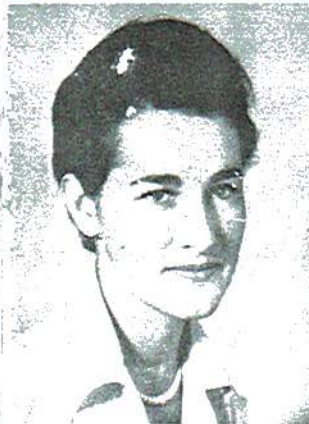
