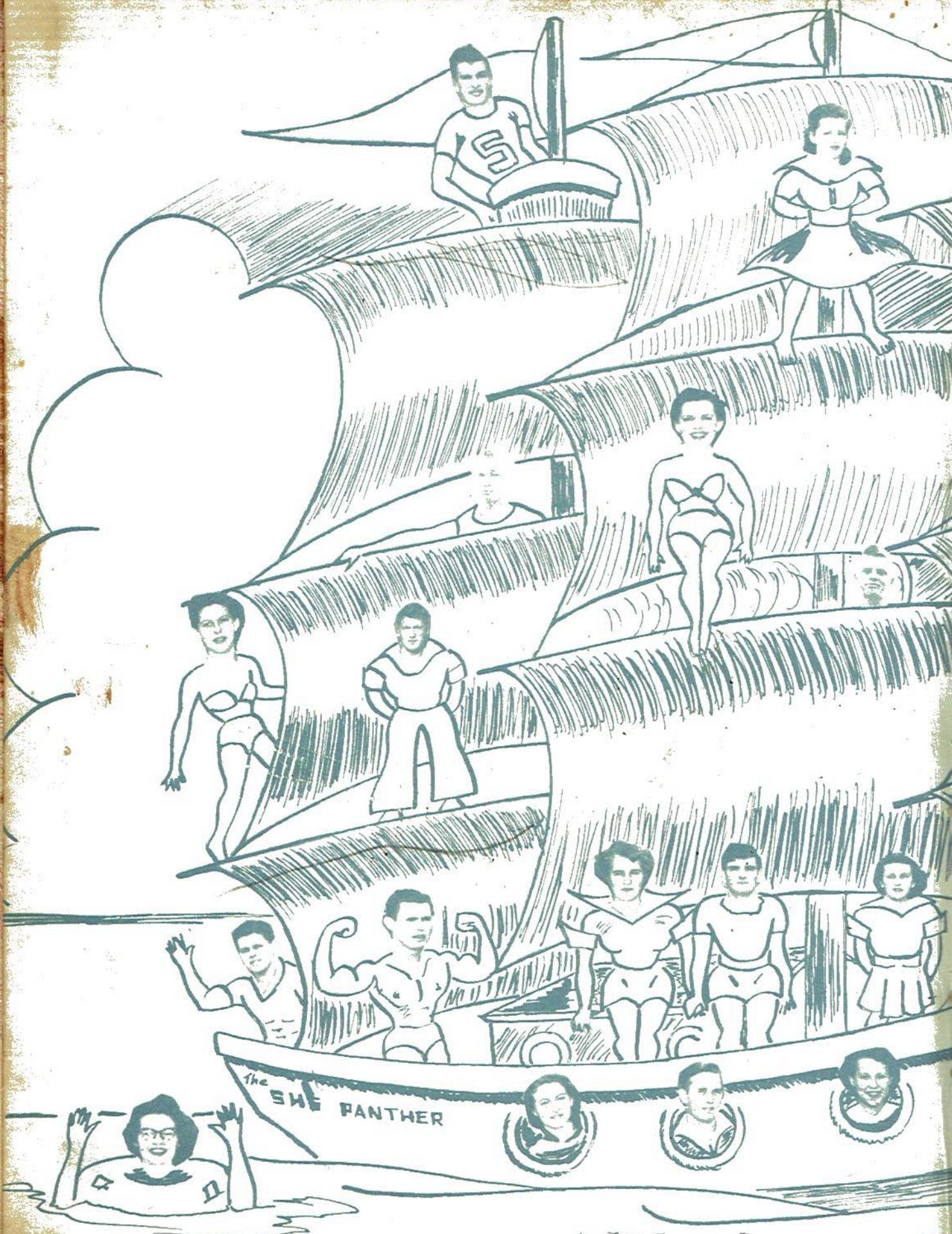

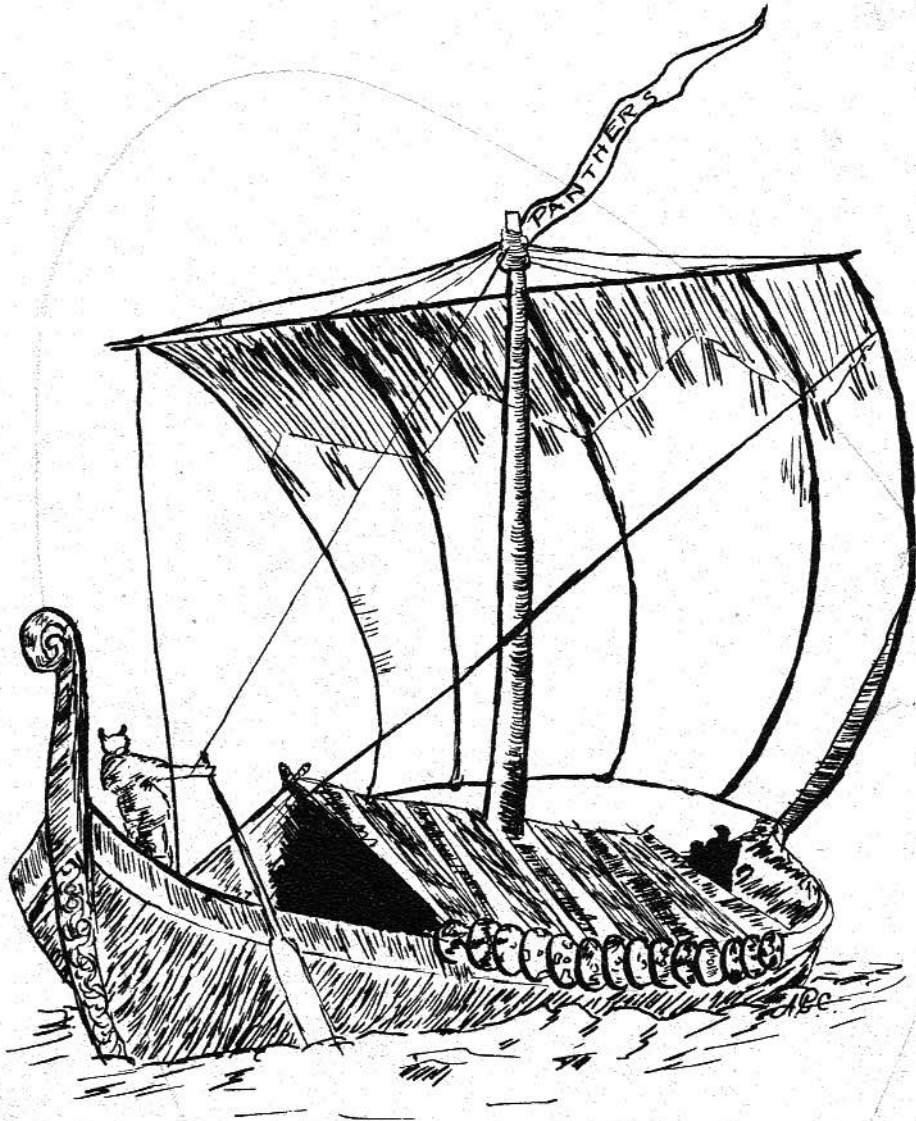

Whose guidance has cleared the way for many storm-bound sailors,

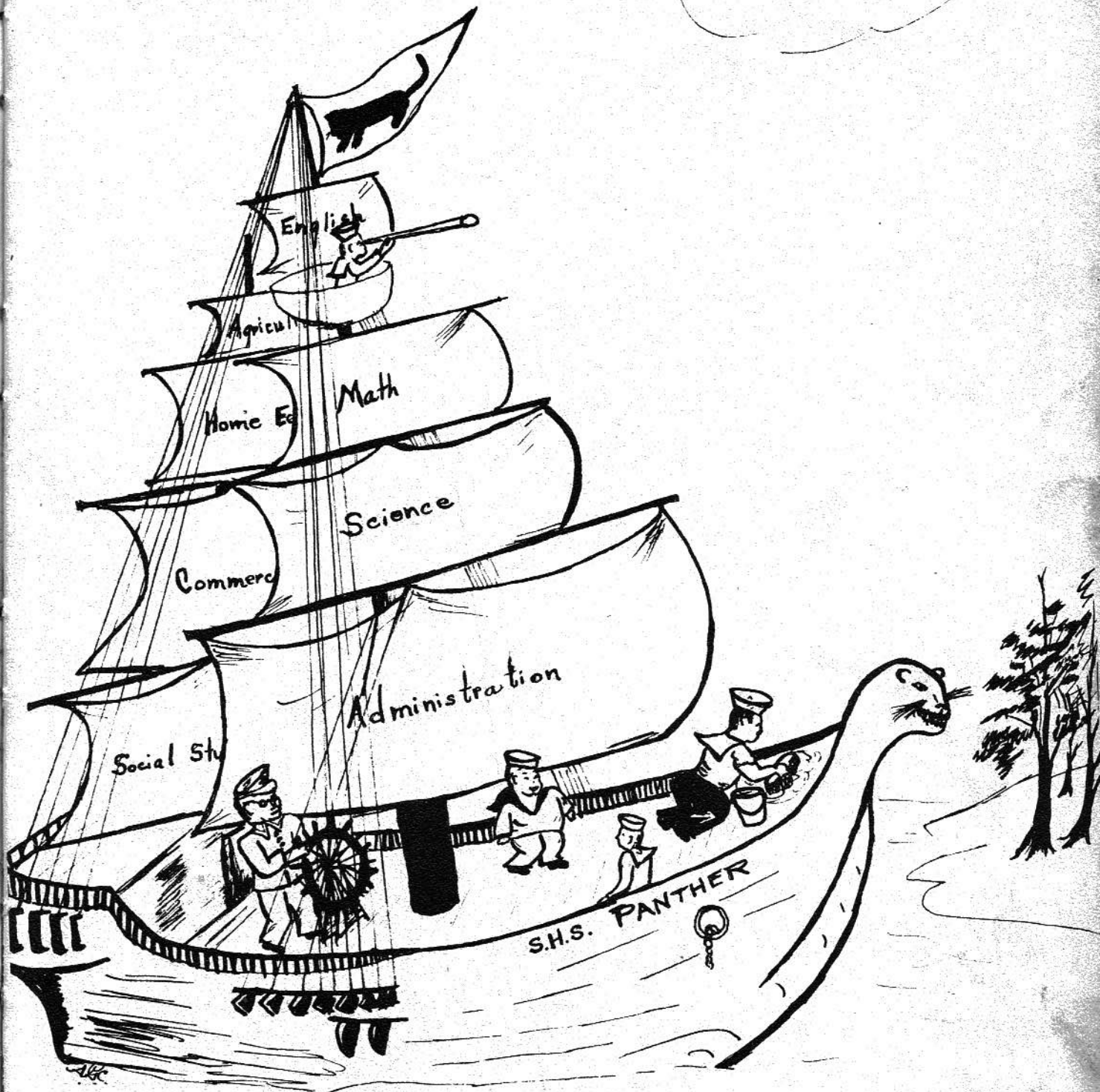
Whose dependability has helped our ships of learning hold a steady course,
