Who has inspired us to focus our telescopes upon distant horizons,


Whose guidance has cleared the way for many storm bound sailors,

Tom Bradford, Senior, is now stationed at Wichita Falls, Texas in the U.S.A.A.F.


R. D. Brown, Sophomore, is in the U.S.A.A.F. at Wichita Falls, Texas.


Franklin Smith, Junior, is stationed at Wichita Falls, also.






