As the smoke clears from the crystal ball, I see Patsy Shepard playing the piano, accompanist for Mary Ann Clemons at the Paint Rock Cafe.

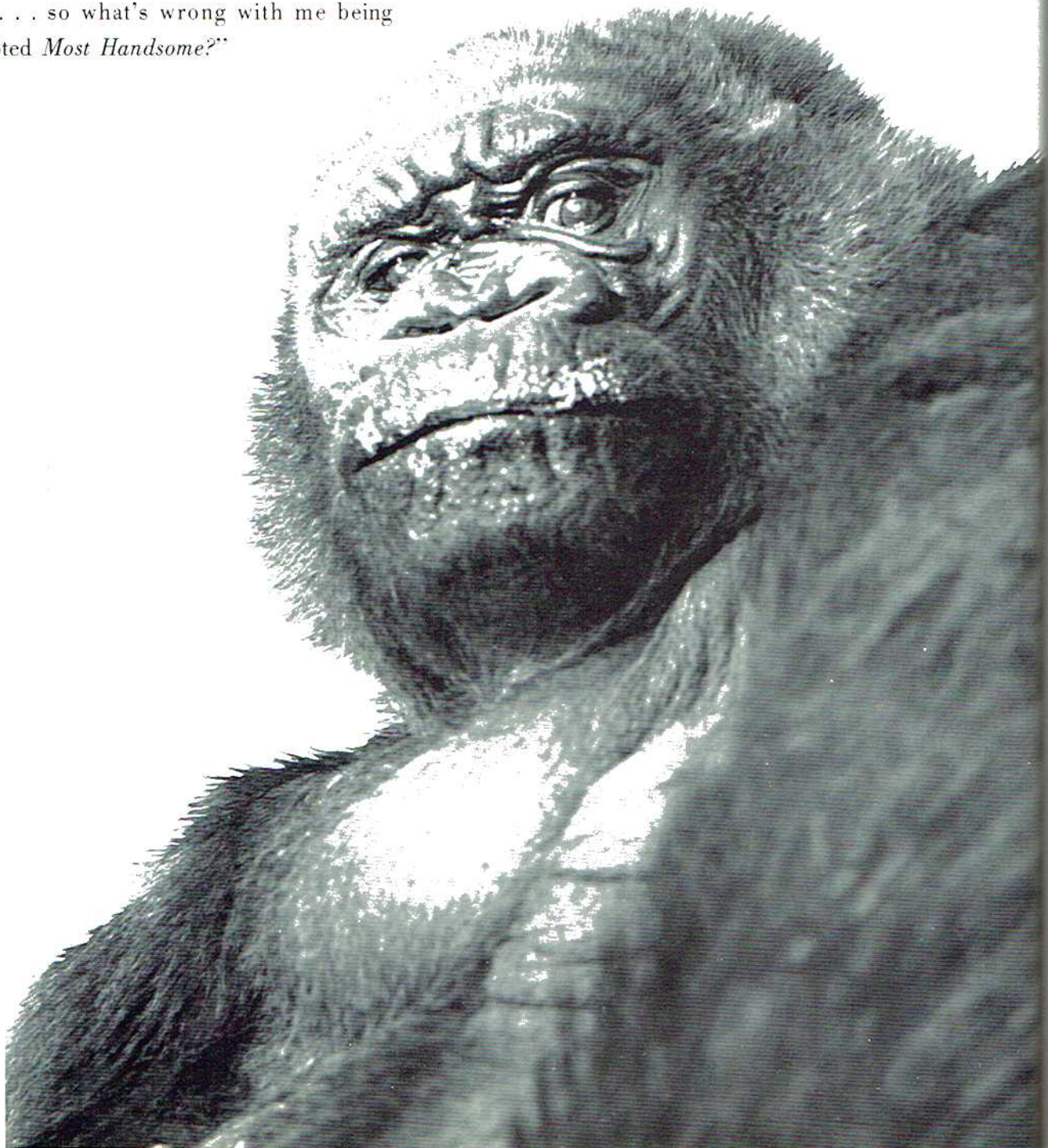
