Jerry West is really living a wonderful life now. He is the best paid baseball player in the National League.

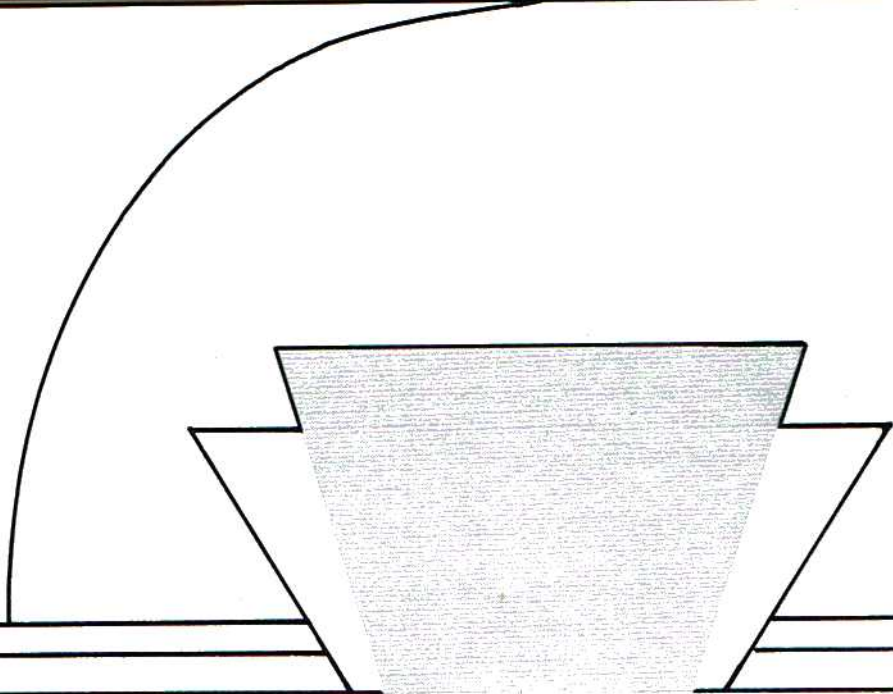

Susie Sims is seen regularly on television. She is the champion lady wrestler of the world.

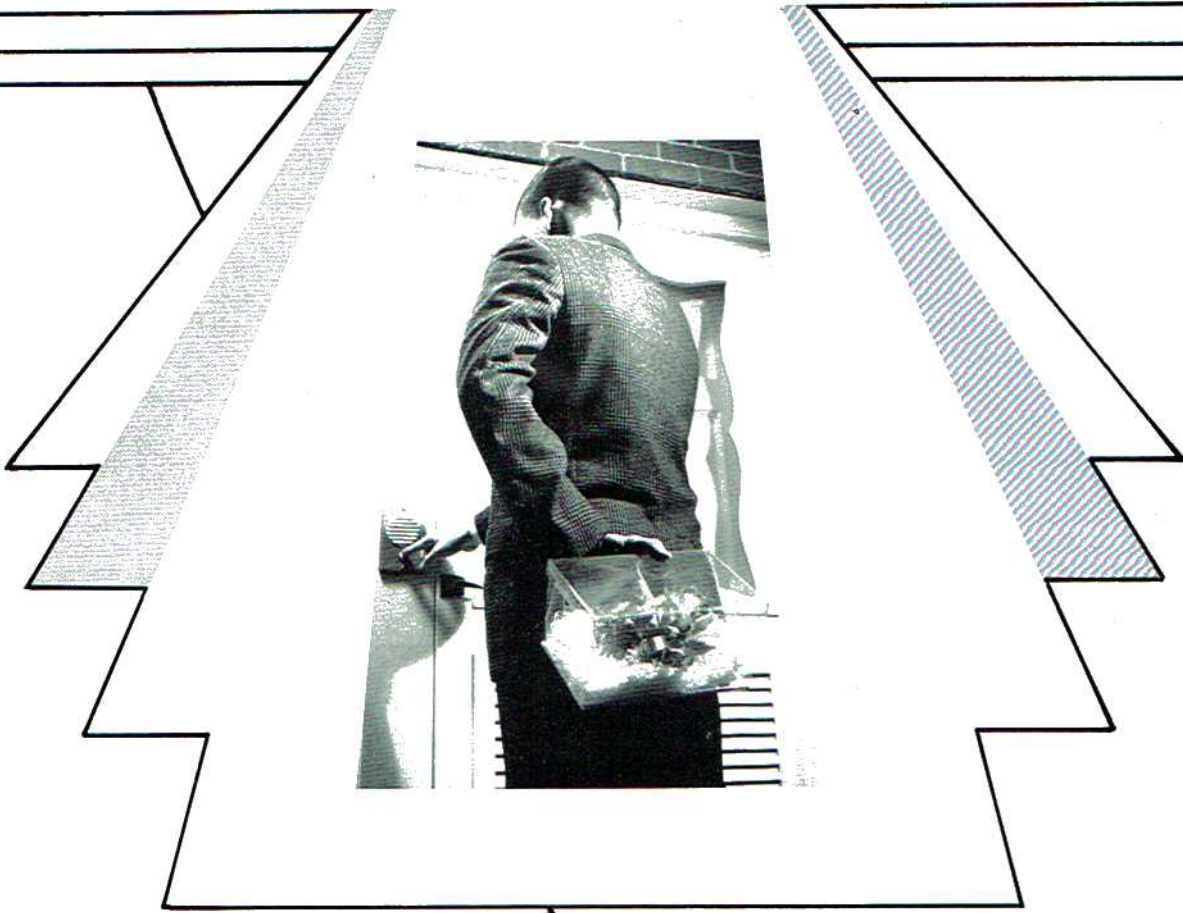
