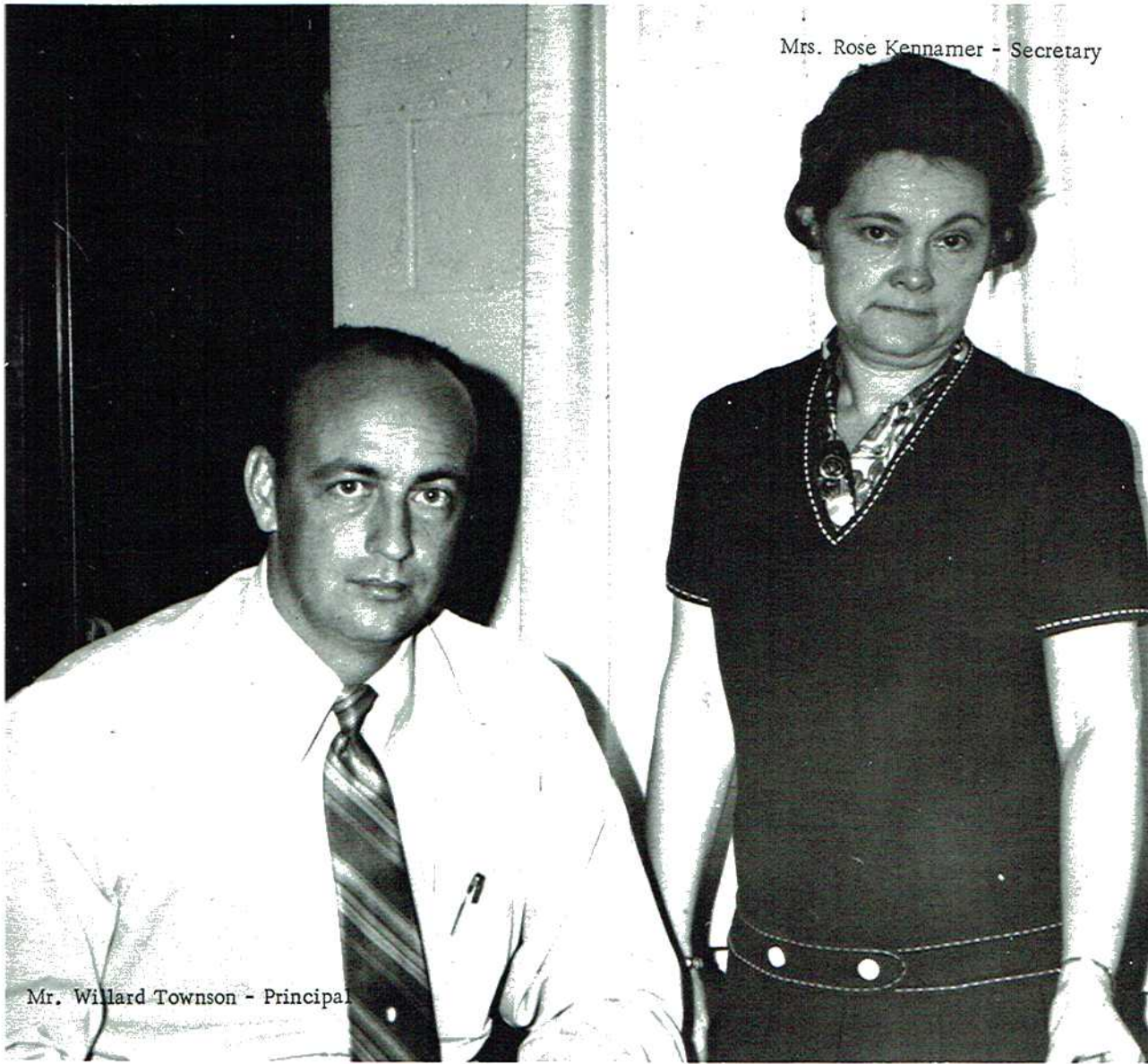

I know I speak for the entire staff and student body when I say we are looking forward to reviewing this work for years to come.

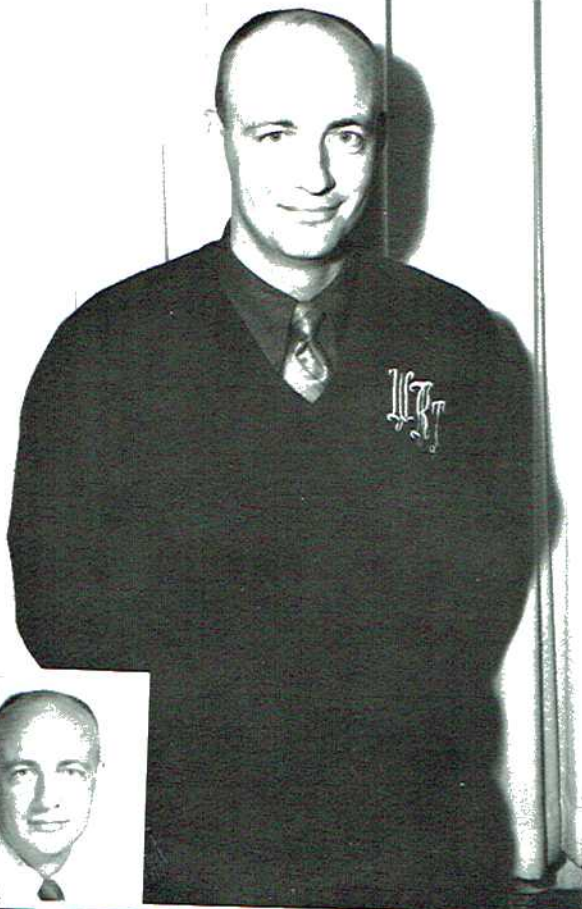
