Polly Folks was born on Oct. 9th - 1804 & died April 15th - 1868, they lived in Giles County, Tennessee. Felix Grundy was their 11th child and the youngest. Felix Grundy Petty, after his service in C. S. Army-First Tenn. Cavalry, Co. K, Ashley Brigade, Humes Division, Wheeler's Corps, Army of Tennessee; surrendered at Raleigh, N. C. married Ary Adaline Adkins, sister of William G. Petty's wife and Dr. C. C. Adkins, in Tennessee 1866. (Giles County ?). They came to Jackson County, Alabama, settled south of Limrock, in Caney Cove. He was Justice of the Peace for years. Brandon and mother Nancy Gold, (daughter of Thomas Gold). The brother and sister  
of Nancy (Brandon) Campbell, Bob Brandon and Mary Brandon (his wife perhaps and  
not his sister) went to Texas after 1899.

The father of S. A. Brewster, was - - - ? Brewster, who was killed on the street  
(of Atlanta, Ga.)

Aunt Lilah - says "that Robert and Michael Johnson were brothers - Frank Dean  
killed Michael Johnson as he was overseeing some negroes.

Emaline Dishroon, daughter of Caleb Dishroon (or Disheroon). Caleb's wife  
was a first cousin of Mont Johnson.

Mike or (Michael Johnson) settled Henrietta Johnson's estate in 1850's, see  
BOOK K - in the basement of the Court House at Scottsboro, Alabama.
