 would have men born a soul farewell till we all shall meet in heaven - But here
 I am in Tennessee once they are in ilinois and I must die, once buried be no
 more hear them noises - Dear Mary you must treat them all well - train them up
 on heaven.

Funeral services for M. Bedford Matthews, 39 - 100 ^{Courtland Ave.} Courtland Avenue who died at his home Tuesday night were held yesterday afternoon in the Burghard - Connally Chapel - The Rev. H. G. Fisher, pastor of the Lutheran Church of the Redeemer officiated, Burial was in the family cemetery. Pallbearers were, W. J. Gruhn - Compton Ugin - R. L. Tombley - Ernest Barnes - Curt Mueller - and W. H. Shiver. Macon Evening News, Wednesday, Jan. 24th - 1940.

M. B. Matthews, died at his home on Tuesday night, January 23rd, 1940 of a heart attack. He was a graduate of The University of Alabama and had lived in Macon, Ga., for 15 years. He was a hard-wood checker and was employed by the Jeffreys-McElrath Manufacturing Company, a lumber company. Mr. Matthews was a son of the late William Jeremiah Matthews & Mrs. Lilah (Johnson) Matthews of Scottsboro, Jackson County, Alabama.

Notes by Mrs. Brockman: Mrs. R. E. Lee says her grandfather, Samuel Jordan Jones lived at Paint Rock near Huntsville, Alabama., and that he was said to be one of the wealthiest men in Northern Alabama. He was the son of Littleberry or Hardeman Jones and wife Jane Scott. Mrs. Lee said her grandmother, Virginia A. Jones was ~~#####~~ a cousin of Samuel Jordan Jones. Her father was Dr. Stith Francis Jones, who was sent from Baltimore, Maryland to Key West, Florida to stamp out yellow fever. He died there in 1856 and the Florida people asked that he be buried there because they loved him so and because of the good he had done them. She says they were of Virginia and Maryland to Florida and Ala.

Note by Gandrud: - Madison County, Alabama marriages show Hardiman Jones to Jane A. Jordan, February 4th - 1820; daughter of Samuel Jordan. Our Vol. 130 p. 47 shows deed of gift from Samuel Jordan to daughter Jane A. wife of Hardyman F. Jones & their son, Samuel J. Jones, 1829.

(Note: This was written by Will Anderson Kyle, ~~#####~~ Nelson Kyle's son.

Some of it seems to be taken from the older Bible mentioned. I doubt that John Kyle died at Greeneville for he sold his land there in October 1812. Florence B. Kyle married William Timmons, April 10th - 1807 in Greene County, Tennessee. In 1815 Edward G. Kyle was of Maury County, Tennessee; in 1817 John M. Kyle was # in Knox County, Tennessee; in 1820, William Timmons and wife Florence of Lincoln county, Tennessee, were sole heirs of John M. Kyle "lately dead intestate".

So if they had a brother Hiram, he must have died in infancy or childhood.
