I DO NOT KNOW THE ORIGIN OF THE SURNAME OF HEMBREE. I DO KNOW THAT IN ANSWER TO THE QUESTION BY MYSELF TO MY GRANDFATHER JAMES FRANKLIN HEMBREE, HE MADE THE STATEMENT THAT THEY WERE NORMANS. THIS KNOWLEDGE WAS HANDED DOWN FROM GENERATION TO GENERATION TO HIM. HISTORY TELL US THAT THE NORMANS WERE IN THE BEGINNING VIKING'S OR NORTHMEN THESE NORTHMEN CONQUERED FRANCE AND FORMED WHAT IS NOW THAT SECTION OF FRANCE KNOWN AS NORMANDY. ABOUT THE YEAR 1000 A.D. THESE NORMANS CONQUERED ENGLAND AND I THINK OUR PEOPLE LIVED IN WHAT IS NOW WALES, ENGLAND, THE NAME OF CARDIFF SHOWS UP IN THE OLD RECORDS AND THAT MAKES ME ALSO THINK THAT THEY LIVED IN THE REGION AROUND CARDIFF, WALES. THE NAME ALSO SHOWS IN THE RECORDS OF THE BARBADOS ISLANDS AND I FEEL THAT THEY WERE SETTLERS IN THE BARBADOS BEFORE COMING TO WHAT IS NOW THE UNITED STATES. I DO NOT KNOW IF THE FIRST ONE OR ONES SETTLED IN NORTH OR SOUTH CAROLINA BUT THINK IT WAS ONE OR THE OTHER. THE OLD RECORDS SHOW THAT THEY WERE HERE LONG BEFORE THE AMERICAN REVOLUTION.

THE HEMBREE COAT OF ARMS IS RECORDED IN THE ENGLISH RECORDS.

I HAVE TRIED TO KEEP MISTAKES OUT OF THIS RECORD, BUT KNOW THERE MUST BE SOME IN IT FOR WE ARE ALL PRONE TO MAKE THEM. I WILL MAKE THE SUGGESTION THAT ANYONE INTERESTED IN THIS RECORD BEYOND JUST THE CASUAL READING OF IT CHECK THE OLD RECORDS TO THEIR OWN SATASFACTION. SO FAR AS MY DIRECT LINE GOES IT IS MY FIRM AND HONEST BELIEF THAT BENJAMIN FRANKLIN HEMBREE OF JACKSON CO., ALABAMA WAS THE SON OF JOEL B. SR. AND HANNAH (PETTIT) HEMBREE FOR MY GRANDFATHER NAMED THEM AS HIS GREAT GRANDPARENTS. FROM THE OLD RECORDS IT IS ALSO MY BELIEF THAT ISAAC LYON HEMBREE AND JOEL B. HEMBREE JR. WERE ALSO THE SONS OF JOEL B. SR. AND HANNAH (PETTIT) HEMBREE BUT I HAVE NO WRITTEN RECORDS THAT STATE THAT THEY WERE THE SONS OF THIS JOEL B. HEMBREE SR. THE GIVEN NAME OF JOEL HAS CAUSED MORE CONFUSION IN THE HUNT FOR THE CORRECT LINES OF DESCENT THAN ANY GIVEN NAME IN THE HEMBREE LINES.

ANYONE WITH INFORMATION BEYOND THAT CONTAINED IN THIS RECORD WILL DO THEIR LINES OF DESCENT A FAVOR BY ADDING THAT INFORMATION IN IT'S PROPER PLACE IN THIS RECORD.

THE RECORDS HERE ARE THE COMBINED EFFORT OF MANY PEOPLE AND ARE NOT MINE ALONE. I VERY GREATLY APPRECIATE EACH AND EVER ITEM THAT THE OTHERS NAME HEREIN HAVE BEEN KIND ENOUGH TO SEND MY WAY.

I do not know just how many were in the family of Joel and Hannah Hembree, the census of 1790 for the Spartanburg District of South Carolina shows a family of ten, the three above named are the only ones that I feel sure of or have more than passing proof about. Of Benjamin F. Hembree I am positive for my grandfather James F. Hembree named Joel and Hannah Hembree as his great grandparents.

In regard to Joel Jr. and Isaac L., all available records from family sources and state and county records leave me with no doubt but that they were also the children of Joel & Hannah Hembree.

A Bible in the possession of C. Bolton Hembree of Springfield, Missouri gives the above date of the death of Joel B. Hembree Sr. No dates in regard to Hannah Hembree appear in the Bible and try as I have her life span is only guess work.

From the records of South Carolina and those of Tennessee, Joel & Hannah Hembree left the Spartanburg District of South Carolina in 1806 and went to Tennessee, settling in Reane Co., land deeds and all information shows that they lived near Cardiff, Post Oak Springs and Reckwood. I think part of the family also lived in what is now Morgan Co., which at that time was a part of Reane.

Joel B. Hembree Sr. obtained by grant about two thousand acres of land from the State of South Carolina over a period of time. All of this land was near Spartanburg, on Cain Creek a branch of the Tyger River. Deeds show that Joel and Hannah disposed of all or the greater part of this land before moving to Tennessee, deeds

show that both Joel and Hannah Hembree purchased land in Tennessee in Roane Co., and also owned land in what is now Morgan Co., Tenn.

Isaac L. Hembree and Joel B. Hembree Jr. were appointed administrators of the estate of Joel B. Hembree Sr. this shows in the county records of Roane Co., Tenn. but the final settlement of that estate showing all the heirs has never been found so far as I know.

Joel Thomas Hembree in the book History of Dade County, Missouri stated that his father was Isaac L. and his mother was Mary (Blake) Hembree and that his grandfather Joel Hembree was a soldier in the Revolutionary War and who emigrated to Roane Co., Tenn. in 1806. There are a number of references to the Revolutionary War service of Joel Hembree and in many cases he is listed as a Colonel in that service, but as yet I have to find proof beyond the statement of Joel T. as I have never found a record of a Joel Hembree in the Revolution in the records of the National Archives. The Daughters of the American Revolution have accepted as fact his service but for me I wish to find proof in the Federal records.

I just do not have the time to list all the land grants and deeds on record in South Carolina or Tennessee but to anyone interested they are there by the score.

At the sale of the personal effects of Joel B. Hembree Sr. at public auction on July 28, 1825 these names as buyers appear Benjamin, Isaac L., Joel, Rosannah and Hannah Hembree. There is no way to tell if this Hannah is the Hannah who was the wife of Joel Sr. or if she was a daughter of Joel and Hannah named Hannah also.

I have a record that for the time is misplaced that states that Hannah and Matilda Hembree were members of The Friendship Baptist Church located ten miles south of the Spartanburg Court House and dated 1804. This I feel sure was Hannah the wife of Joel Sr. and Matilda the wife of Joel Jr. The family of Joel Hembree shows in the 1790 census of Spartanburg and in the 1800 census of Spartanburg but does not show in the census of Spartanburg for the year of 1810. This is further proof that they had removed to Tennessee, though other Hembrees do show in the Spartanburg census of 1810 and later. In the Roane Co., Tenn. census of 1840 both a Joel B. Hembree and a Col. Joel Hembree show, this Col. Joel was the son of Joel B. Jr. The census records are too numerous to record here but they can provide these interested with many hours of thought and study.

I do not know who the parents of Joel B. Hembree Sr. were but I do have this record from the Archives of North Carolina -----

James and David Hembree were listed on the Muster Roll of a Regiment in Granville County, North Carolina under the Command of Col. William Eaton, dated Oct. 8, 1754 & Sept. 6, 1755.

Then in the records of South Carolina is this, James Hembree obtained a grant of 200 acres of land on Cain Creek a branch of Tyger River dated 1772.

It could be that this James and David Hembree were the two brothers that my grandfather stated came to this country by the way or from the Barbados Islands, and it could also be that this James Hembree was the father of Joel B. Sr. and the ancestor of all of us who trace back to Spartanburg, and this David the ancestor of all who trace back to North Carolina.

I have a number of records of lines with the Hembree surname, but the connections if any are not known to me. In other words they do not connect up through any known generation to myself from before or after Joel and Hannah (Pettit) Hembree. I have no doubt but that a connection is there if it could only be found.

I do know that a number by the name served in the American Revolution. I think these men who served in that war were at least a second generation in this country.

The spelling of the name and the pronouncing of it has been found and heard in many forms as all who bear the name know. For the greater part it is pronounced with the H silent as in the French form. This pronouncing with the H silent has been used by both members and non-members of the name, has caused the loss of many lines and records. For the greater part if spelled by others it will turn up in the records as Embry, Embrie, Embree, Emry and Hembrie or Hembry or Hembrey. In the case of the 1790 census records for the district of Spartanburg, South Carolina it shows as Joel Emry. This was in reality Joel B. Hembree Sr. In no case have I ever found a census record of that year in S.C. with the name spelled correct. Here is the census of 1790 for Spartanburg.

In the census of 1810 for Spartanburg these names show William Embry, Owen Hembree and Hez Embree.

In the census of 1820 for Spartanburg these names show William W. Hembree, Abram Hembree, Easter Hembree, Nancy Hembree, William Hembree, James Hembree, Johnson Hembree, William Hembree, Emerich Embree and John Hembrie.

The census records of that day and time must be taken with a grain of salt, for no one trusted the purpose of the census and if the taker spelled the name wrong that was fine so far as the people went. It seems also to have been the proper thing to give wrong ages and leave out any member that did not show in the door when the census taker came around.

It always gives me a great amount of pleasure to obtain information and to give it to those interested for no one person is allotted enough time on this earth to obtain more than a fraction by themselves.

in hand paid by the said Lee Clark, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged; hath given granted, Bargained & Sold unto the said Lee Clark, his Heirs, Executors, Administrators & afsigns, One certain tract or parcel of Land, Situate lying & being in the County of Spartanburg & on the North side of Tyger River near Cain Creek, Beginning at a Post-Oak Corner thence north Seventy - Five Degrees East Sixty One Chains to a Post-Oak Corner thence North forty five degrees west fifty-five chains to a leaning oak corner: thence south forty seven degrees west thirty - four chains to a Hickory Corner, thence south ten degrees east thirty three chains to the first Station containing two hundred & thirteen acres, more or lefs, Together with all Houses, Buildings, Orchards Trees Timber trees, ways, waters, water cources, with every part & article thereof to warrant & forever defend - with all the right, Title, Claim, Interest & demand of the said Joel Hembree & Hannah his wife, of in, and to the said Tract of Land & premises: Free & Clear from all Hindrence Molestation or Incumberance of the said Joel Hembree & Hannah his wife and from any other person or persons or the Heirs, Executors & Afsigns of him the said Joel Hembree & Hannah his wife, but the said Tract of Land & primeses with every oppertenance thereunto to belonging, or in anywise appertaining shall be to the only use and behoof of him the said Lee Clark his Heirs Exececutors, Administrators & Afsigns in witness whereof the said Joel Hembree & Hannah his wife hath hereunte set their hands & affixed their Seals this the day & year first above written.

They tell the story of a horse belonging to Joel Hembree that was needed by the army and lost in some expedition of the Rev. War and of his claim for the value of the horse and the payment of the state to him for it.

The above tell us that Joel Hembree had removed to the State of Tennessee and that he had given a deed to John Browning for the land before he left South Carolina, that John Browning had lost the deed and went to Tennessee and went to Tennessee in company with John Thornton and requested another deed from Joel Hembree which he gave as stated.

John Browning must have been absent minded for it took him from Dec. of 1806 to May of 1807 to have this deed recorded.

This land is in a plot that was granted to Joel Hembree of which I have a copy.

The Joel Hembrees of Roane County,Tennessee, by that I mean the three named above have caused more confusion by the way they signed their names than any three people I have ever tried to trace, I think I have gone through this before but will do so again, because of that confusion. I have photo copies of the signatures of the three above named men, and while I am no expert at that business, it takes no expert to be able to see that they were not written by one and the same, but were written by three seperate hands.

You will note that Joel Hembree husband of Hannah (Pettit) Hembree signed as Joel Hembree all the way through.

While his father was living Joel B.Hembree Jr. signed as Joel B.Hembree Jr. After his father died he signed as Joel B.Hembree.

In the census records of Roane Co.,Tenn. we find that while his father Joel B. Hembree Jr. was living Col.Joel Hembree is listed in the census as Col.Joel, and after the death of his father he signed simply as Joel Hembree.

Then we go another generation and we have Joel Dallas Hembree son of Col. Joel and Joel Thomas Hembree son of Isaac L.Hembree, and so it goes on and on.

After the death of Margaret (Lyles) Hembree, Benjamin Franklin Hembree married Mary Ann (Glasscock) Parton, the widow of James Parton. Mary Ann Glasscock was the daughter of Spencer and Mary (Enochs) Glasscock she was born in Rowan Co., North Carolina in 1792. Mary Hembree applied for a pension on the strength of the service of Benjamin F. Hembree in the War of 1812. In her application she stated she was married to Benjamin F. Hembree at Nickajack Cave, Tennessee. Mary Hembree also stated in her application that she saw Benjamin F. Hembree buried about a mile from Bridgeport, Alabama.

Mary Ann Glasscock was a sister to Moses Herndon Glasscock Sr. who was the father of Amelia Glasscock wife of Joseph B. Hembree and he was also the father of Elizabeth Emaline Glasscock the wife of Robert Lyles Hembree Sr.

My grandfather James Franklin Hembree and the children of Robert Lyles Hembree Sr. were double first cousins.

The spelling of this surname is confusing to me to say the least, for Robert Leyel or Lyell used both Leyel and Lyell in signing papers in support of his claim for service in the American Revolution. Some of those in Alabama spell it Liles and I guess I just like Lyles the better, but never the less Robert Lyles or Leyel or Lyell was a native of Scotland and served as a Captain of Rangers in the State of South Carolina at the start of that war and then accepted the commission of Major in the Militia of that state and was present through the siege of Charleston. In his first petition to the House of Representatives of the Colonies for a pension he spelled the name as LEVEL. Then in a petition for pay for goods furnished the the Continental Army he spelled it as LYELL, so if he was not sure then I am sure not.

Never the less this was the father of Margaret (Lyles) Hembree and her mothers maiden name was Sarah Newnan.

I have not traced out very much of the Lyles line but have enough to feel that this was the correct Robert Lyles or Leyel or Lyell.

The records from the National Archives show that Robert LYELL served as a Captain in the 3rd South Carolina Regiment of Continental Troops, commanded by Col. William Thompson.

From the old records the best that I can understand it is that he was wounded and mustered out of the service before the close of the war, but he also pressed his claim for pay for both service and goods untill he was paid in true Scott fashion.

Family tradition tells that he was red headed and lived to the age of 106.

From this man comes the given name of Robert used down through many branches of the family, for instance it came to me this way

Joseph B. Hembree was known as both Joel and Jose Hembree, but his correct name was Joseph. His middle given name is in doubt to me, for his son knew his father as Joel Blackwell Hembree and so named his oldest child. Family records in Alabama state that the given name was Blackburn, I do not know which given middle name is correct Blackwell or Blackburn. Robert Lyles Hembree Sr., a brother to Joseph B. Hembree stated that his brother was named Joseph.

My grandfather James Franklin Hembree, knew and remembered the date his father was captured by the Union Army, which was Oct. 1, 1863.

The Confederate army records and the Union army records both give this date that he was captured, he was too seriously ill to travel far, and for some unknown reason, the Union army sent him to Stevenson, Alabama in place of sending him to the regular army prison camps in the north.

The Union army records state that J. B. Hembree died Nov. 2, 1863 in a Union army hospital near Stevenson, Alabama.

Moses H. Glasscock Jr. had obtained leave from the Confederate army to try to take J. B. Hembree who was his brother-in-law through the Union lines to the home of Sophia (Bible) Glasscock, where they were both captured, Moses H. Glasscock Jr. was sent to Ft. Delaware, Delaware and confined for the duration of the war. After the war he came to Lamar Co., Texas, he was also a member of Co. G. 3rd. Regt. of Confederate Cavalry, Army of the Tennessee.

I will not state as a known fact that Hannah (Pettit) Hembree was his mother she could have been a step-mother, but Joel B. Hembree Sr. was the father, I think this Joel B. Jr. was the oldest son of Joel B. Sr., that he married Matilda ? in South Carolina and Joel Hembree was born there. I do not know if Matilda died or just what happened but Joel B. Jr. married Sally Wilhite in Roane Co., Tenn. as stated and his son Joel listed his children in his will on record in Roane Co., Tenn., and they are not the children of Joel B. Jr. and Sally (Wilhite) Hembree. I think Joel B. The Military records of Col. Joel Hembree are on file in the National Archives, Washington, D.C. and cover many years and wars.

He lived and died at the old Hembree home place near Cardiff, Tennessee. The house stood from 1806 until 1966, the family cemetery is on this place.

All I can state here that anyone interested beyond this record in Roane Co., Tennessee can expect to find some very hard work in these records, as the old saying states "If you lose track in Tennessee you are sure lost".

Any one with definite proof on Joel B. Hembree Jr. and his children, can do many a great favor by coming forth with the information.

I will call this the Oregon line; I do not know the connection between this line and those of Tennessee, South and North Carolina.

The way it comes to me is that two brothers went to Oregon in 1843, that they were named Absalom and Joel Jordan Hembree sons of a Joel James Hembree. One source states that this Joel James Hembree removed from North Carolina to Tennessee and his two sons went on to Oregon with the Applegate company in 1843. The grave of a young boy aged seven years named Joel Hembree was found on the Oregon trail a few years ago and the records of the Applegate company tells that he was run over by a wagon and killed. This boy was the son of either Absalom or Joel Jordan Hembree. The given name of Absalom shows up in the Hembree lines about as often as Joel or Joseph.

Another version of the origin of the Hembree lines in America comes from a descendant of this Joel Jordan Hembree, but it is so far out of line with the recorded facts that it is not worth the effort to write it here.

I have found some trace of a James Hembree in the records of Morgan Co., Tennessee and think that this was the Joel James Hembree of the Oregon line

The given names of this Oregon line are enough to make me say there was a direct connection back in North and South Carolina.

I have left blank pages through this record, for the use of those who may be interested in adding information of which I have no knowledge. This record contains the result of years of hard work, of which I have had the pleasure of helping to put together. I will say to anyone who may come into the possession of this record in later years, to think a long time before they let it be lost or destroyed, for it can never again be put together after our generation is gone. The cost alone, if the work here had been done by a professional genealogist would be in the thousand and thousands of dollars. So keep it, it will not come your way again.
